Description of Categories:

Events that have the capacity to cause error but none occurred.

An error occurred but the med did not reach the patient.

Category A
Category B
Category C An error that reached the patient but did not cause the patient harm or require increased monitoring.

Category D An error that resulted in the need for increased patient monitoring but no patient harm.

Category E An error that resulted in a temporary change in patient condition and required increased monitoring. Treatment or intervention may have been required.

Category F An error that resulted in initial or prolonged hospitalization and caused patient harm.

Category G An error that resulted in permanent patient harm.

Category H An error that resulted in a near death event (i.e., anaphylaxis, cardiac arrest).

Category I An error that resulted in patient death.
